## ORDER

COMES NOW the Court, having reviewed the file and the Motion of Judgment Creditor, the responses of Barbara A. Robbins, the Trial Memorandum of the Judgment Creditor, and finds and orders as follows:

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. This case was initiated by Barbara A. Robbins on behalf of NorthStar Design & Construction, LLC.
- 2. The judgment creditors, Defendants in that action, lodged a Counterclaim seeking damages under various theories, including breach of contract and breach of the Colorado Consumer Protection Act.

- 3. On October 8, 2002, judgment was entered in favor of the Defendant/Counterclaimants, the judgment creditors herein, and against NorthStar Design & Construction in the amount of \$28,477.15.
- 4. It is undisputed that Barbara A. Robbins operated NorthStar Design & Construction, LLC as an limited liability company between 1996 and April, 2001, even though the company was not licensed by the State and a certificate establishing NorthStar Design & Construction as a limited liability company was not issued until April, 2001.
- 5. All of the dealings between the judgment creditors herein and NorthStar Design & Construction occurred prior to the time that entity became a limited liability company.
- 6. All of those dealings were with Barbara A. Robbins or individuals acting at her direction.
- 7. The judgment creditors herein have presented this matter to the Court along with a request that the judgment entered against NorthStar Design & Construction, LLC be entered against Barbara A. Robbins individually.
- 8. Although having filed certain documents and pleadings in response to the judgment creditors' motions, Barbara A. Robbins did not appear at the hearing on this matter.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. The statute made and provided sets forth the following:

All persons who assume to act as a limited liability company without authority to do so and without good faith belief that they have such authority shall be jointly and severally liable for all debts and liabilities incurred by such persons so acting.

## C.R.S. § 7-80-105.

- 2. Ms. Robbins asserts that in 1996 she submitted an application on behalf of NorthStar Design & Construction and that application was returned to her by the Secretary of State because of errors therein. She asserts that her failure to resubmit was an oversight and, essentially, she should be allowed the protection afforded an LLC as a defacto LLC.
- 3. The principal of *defacto* corporations or limited liability companies has no application in Colorado. *Bowers Building Co. v. Altura Glass Co.*, 694 P.2d 876 (Colo.

App. 1984). The existence of a limited liability company commences when a certificate is issued by the Secretary of State. The Court would further note that this holding is in keeping with the appellate court's analysis in *Hong v. Arbess*, 80 P.3d 863 (Colo. App. 2003).

4. It is, therefore, ordered that the judgment heretofore entered in this case against NorthStar Design and Construction, LLC, in the amount of \$28,477.15 is entered against said Barbara A. Robbins jointly and severally.
