Considering the actions that you and your representative have taken against me, which are potentially damaging business wise, I feel I am entitled to a reasonable answer concerning my questions.

Failing a reasonable answer and reasonable proof, I will be forced to file a counternotice under the DMCA which allows for me to challenge your takedown under copyright law.

I have already contacted eBay and requested the counternotice form.

It will be easier for both sides to resolve this before getting into legal paperwork.

Since I was not a willing alleged infringer I should not have a black mark against my business account. I was merely reselling lawfully acquired copyrighted fabric from a reputable manufacturer, Shamash and Sons, and a reputable distributor which is expressly allowed under the First Sale Doctrine. Had you or your company taken reasonable steps and contacted me first we could have resolved this much easier.

The mark must be removed from my account.
